Upper-Division Business Courses. All students, regardless of class standing, taking upper-division Business Courses, will be charged an additional \$68.00 per credit hour for credits taken in upper-division courses (3000-5999) in the School of Business.

Undergraduate Business Courses. Students participating in the following undergraduate programs, in the David Eccles School of Business, will be assessed a \$50.00 program fee each semester: ASAP program, Intermediate Business Status, and Full Major Status

Business Masters Courses. All students, regardless of class standing, taking Business Masters Courses, will be charged an additional \$314.62 per credit hour for credits taken in graduate level courses in the School of Business.

Upper-Division Nursing Courses. All students regardless of class standing will be charged an additional \$35.00 per credit hour for credits taken in upper-division courses (3000-5999) in the College of Nursing.

Upper-Division Engineering Courses. All students regardless of class standing will be charged an additional \$35.00 per credit hour for credits taken in upper-division courses (3000-5999) in the College of Engineering , beginning Fall 2009.

Engineering Graduate Courses. All students, regardless of class standing, will be charged an additional \$50.00 per credit hour for credits taken in graduate courses (6000 and Above) in the College of Engineering , beginning Fall 2009.

Special Course Fees. For those courses requiring them, special fees are shown in a column of the course listings. These fees, which must be paid with tuition, are in addition to regular tuition and mandatory fee charges.

Mandatory Fees. The mandatory fees include the following fees: ASUU Activity, Athletic, Building, Collegiate Reader Program, Computing, Fine Arts, Utilities, Health, Library, Publication Council, Recreation, Study Abroad, Sustainability, and Transportation. The amounts for these fees are included in the Tuition and Fee schedule listed above. (Please note: The \$3.00 Study Abroad Fee is not charged to Students who are Seniors prior to the beginning of the Semester).

Summer term tuition and fees. Both resident and nonresident students are assessed resident tuition and fees during the Summer term.

Matriculation Fee (\$70.00). This fee will be assessed of all undergraduate students entering the University of Utah for the first time. This fee covers the cost of the new student orientation, credit evaluation, writing placement exam, graduation evaluation, and registration with the Career Services Center.

Other Important Information

Online Tuition Payment. You can pay your tuition online using a credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover, or American Express) or with an e-check. You must access the Campus Information System to use this option. The Campus Information System is available most hours of the day, however, system maintenance is scheduled between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 3:00 a.m. (US Mountain Time) daily and the system may be unavailable during this time.

Tuition Equal Payment Plan. For information on this plan, visit the Academic Management Services TuitionPay website. Academic Management Services (AMS) is an independent company which has been engaged by the University to provide this service.

Direct Deposit - This is an option to receive your tuition account refunds electronically. An on-line application can be completed by accessing the Campus Information System.
